The day will close with a Panel Discussion on the topic of the Policy Recommendations, prepared by the HerMan-project. We also welcome you to meet for an official dinner afterwards.

Friday, November 28th, the internal HerMan-meeting takes place. We will hear about important issues regarding the finalisation of the project, but also about perspectives of future Co-operation and funding opportunities. Like in every good project we need to review what we learned, where we faced challenges, and how we overcame difficulties. Before the conference ends on Friday afternoon a guided Tour, either through the Old Town Regensburg, or through the World Heritage Visitor Centre, is offered. 




